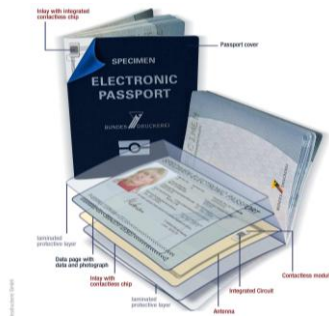


Banken im Besitz der Rothschild Familie

Es ist der allgemeinen Bevölkerung im Wesentlichen Länder unbekannt, dass der Modus Operandi der Wirtschafts- und Finanzordnung in den USA von 1933 hauptsächlich auf den Prinzipien der Bankentrennung nach dem Glass-Steagall-Gesetz beruhte, Trennbankensystem in der Politik. Teile dieser regulierenden Prinzipien wurden in jener Zeit auch in Europa angewendet, wo es aber im Unterschied zur USA ein Universalbankensystem gab. Im Rahmen dieses Gesetzes, welches durch die Senatoren Carter Glass und Henry Steagall erarbeitet und von Franklin D. Roosevelt 1933 Carter Glass verabschiedet wurde, wurden die Finanzinstitute streng in Investmentbanken und Geschäftsbank.
